The Department of Family and Community Medicine at Southern Illinois University School of Medicine is seeking a motivated and innovative Program Director for its SIU Decatur Family and Community Residency Program in Decatur, IL. This program is one of four SIU affiliated Family Medicine Residency Programs in Central and Southern Illinois. The Decatur program is a community based, medical school administered program with five residents per year and strong community hospital support.

The qualified physician must be a graduate of an accredited residency program, be Board Certified in Family Medicine, have five years experience as faculty in a Family Medicine residency program and possess or be eligible for an unrestricted Illinois license to practice medicine. Experience in Obstetrics is desirable, but optional. The SIU Family Medicine Residency Program was certified in 2011 as a Level 2 Patient Centered Medical Home.
