



Leaders for Ozaukee's Next Generation (LONG)

Leaders for Ozaukee's Next Generation (LONG) is a nine-session leadership development program designed to build the leadership skills of professionals who live or work in Ozaukee County.

Participants meet once a month at different locations throughout the county to learn about key aspects of community leadership. Each session lasts three hours and includes opportunities for networking and a meal.

Leadership topics include:

- Effective communication
- Presentation and public speaking
- Emotional intelligence
- Diversity training
- Community partnerships
- Community involvement

Throughout the program, participants also work collaboratively on a community-based project and present the project to their peers.

At the conclusion of the program, participants receive a University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee School of Continuing Education Leadership Professional Certificate.
