DO NOT BRING:

- *Illegal Drugs
- *Biohazardous Material
- *Personal Care Products (ex: shampoo, soap, toothpaste, deodorants)
- *Household Hazardous Waste (ex: paint, cleaners, and batteries)

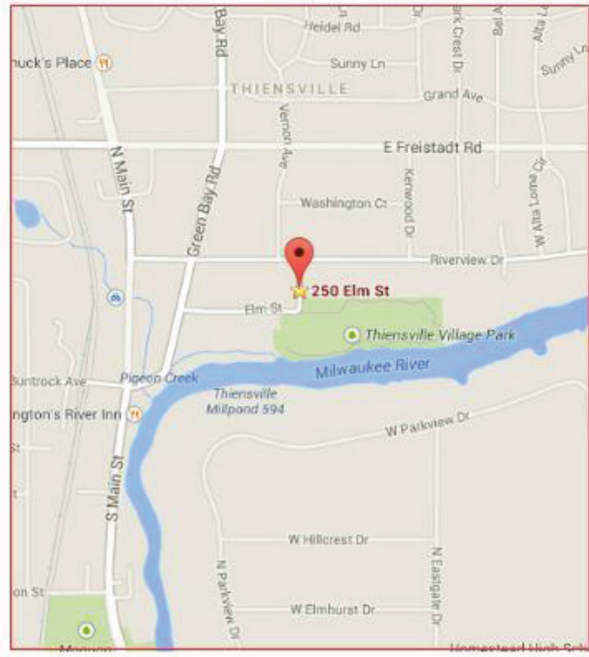
HOW DOES THE COLLECTION WORK?

- Drive through the drop-off area and hand your medication(s) to a student pharmacist or volunteer

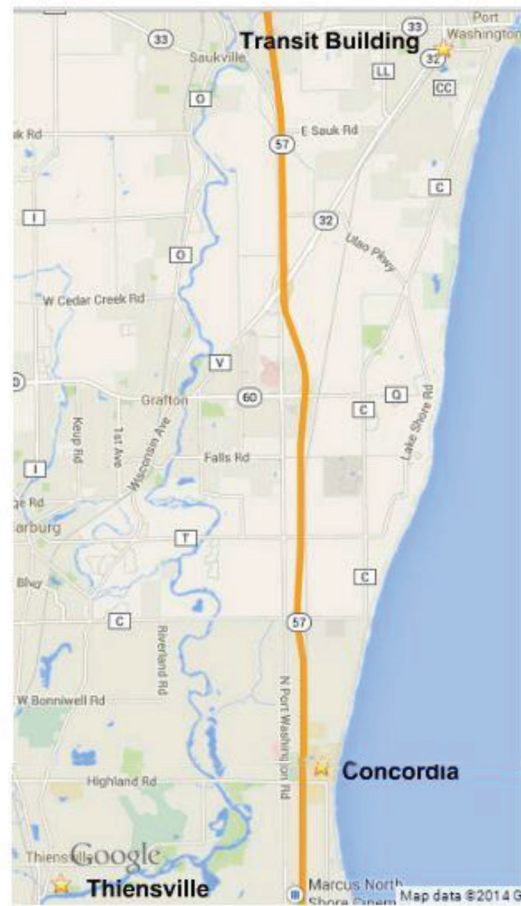

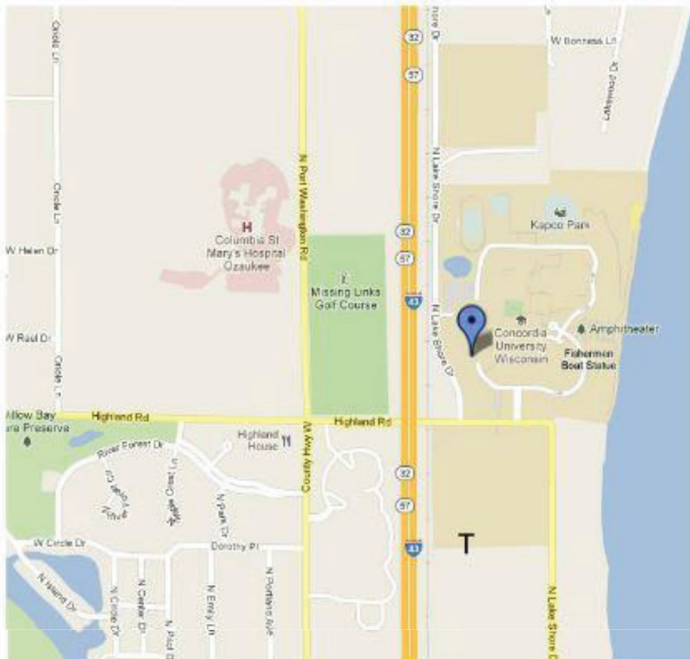
Site Locations
