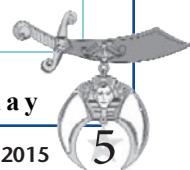

Hendersonville Shrine Club

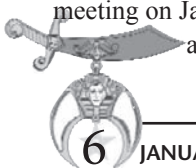
Once again we are looking forward to a new year under the leadership of new Potentate Mike Van Sant. He can hardly wait to put some of his good ideas to work for 2015.

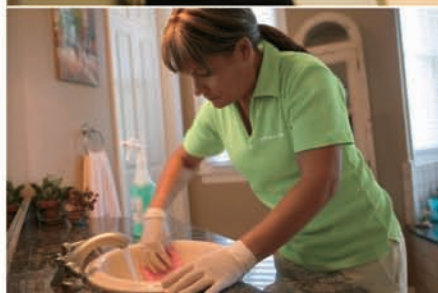
