The International Poultry Scientific Forum at the Georgia World Congress Center, January 26-27, is the new year's first major venue for research in poultry health and performance.

IPSF studies include research on Diamond V AviCare™, liquid poultry supplement for periods of high stress, as well as the latest findings on Original XPC™ in poultry.
