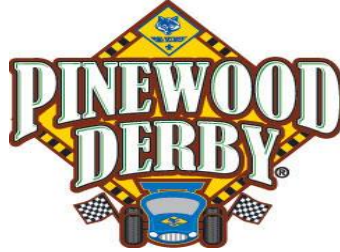

Registration is limited to the first 80 cars!!

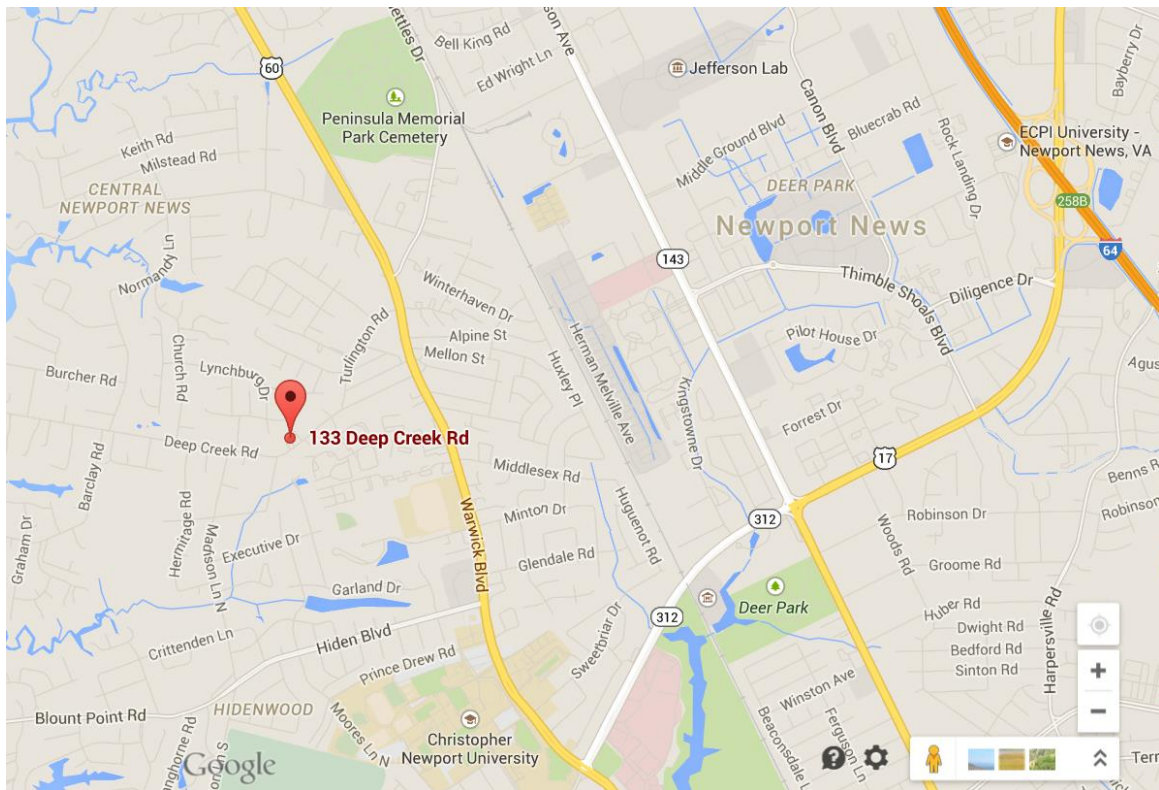

James River District Pinewood 2015 Open Race Rules

1. The race track has four lanes, and an electronic finish timing system that is computer controlled. The computer captures each car's elapsed time and speed during each of its races. Each car will race four times (once in each lane). Results are determined by fastest average time. The overall First, Second and Third place winners will be designated by the computer, based on the results of the Level races. The car with the fastest average time of the day will be the Open Champion.
2. **Overall car length of the car shall not exceed 7", overall width shall not exceed 2 3/4", distance between the wheels shall be at least 1 3/4" and overall height shall not exceed 3".**
3. **Clearance to the bottom of the car when resting on its wheels must be at least 3/8"** so it will not rub on the lane strip.
4. **Car weight shall not exceed 5 Oz.** Weight may be added to lighter cars to bring them up to 5 Oz., but may not exceed 5 Oz.
5. Starting devices are prohibited. Cars must be freewheeling.
6. Wheels and axels may be lubricated with any dry lubricant; but excess lubricant must be wiped off, so as not to foul the track.
7. Notes to Drivers:
 - a. **Only Participants are authorized into the Pit Area.**
 - b. There will not be a lube area in the Pit Area and lubrication, if desired, must be applied by the participants before check in. **Have your cars ready to race BEFORE you check in.**
 - c. Participant may only enter the Pit Area if their group is racing. Participants will not be allowed to touch their car after it is has been checked in. If repairs are needed, the participant under the supervision of a race official and his parent (if applicable) may try to make repairs to his car at the repair table next to the Pit area.
 - d. All participants must be present to race their own car. Race Marshalls will be available at each station to assist.
 - e. If a car jumps the track during a race, that race will be run again. If the same car jumps the track on the rerun of the race, it will count as one (1) loss for that car.
 - f. Final interpretation of the Race Rules shall be on the authority of the District Derby Chairman.
