Interprofessional Medication Reconciliation Program

January 12, 2015

Newly registered BC pharmacists (2007-2013) practicing in or near Victoria, Prince George and Kelowna are invited to join more than 550 Pharmacy 3rd year, Medicine and Nursing 4th year, and Nurse Practitioner students in an innovative Interprofessional Medication Reconciliation Program continuing education program. This event will be held in Victoria, Prince George and Kelowna, as well as on the UBC Vancouver campus.

Groups of eight multidisciplinary learners will participate in an engaging and collaborative problem-solving session related to a patient's medication use across transitions of care. Situated in a hospital discharge planning meeting, participants will evaluate a complex patient case, document medication discrepancies, and propose recommendations to ensure accurate and complete medication information transfer at discharge. A facilitated debriefing session will follow to consolidate learning.

After this session you will have acquired the skills to efficiently perform Medication Reconciliation at transitions of care. This will allow you to further expand your scope of practice in communicating medication discrepancies with other healthcare professionals and optimizing patient's medications. Furthermore, you will be able to generate a BPMH more proficiently for use when completing Medication Reviews.

The live continuing education activities will take place at university locations in Victoria, Prince George and Kelowna 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. on Monday, January 12, 2015.
