LIncoln County War

Travel back in time with a ranger and a living history actor to a period in history dominate d by land disputes, developing settlements, and lawlessness in territorial New Mexico. Discover the unique history of the Land of Enchantment and the events leading up to the Lincoln County War. Learn about the interesting clash of cultures and historic flgures, such as New Mexico's most infamous outlaw, Billy the Kid, who may show up to explain events as he remembers. These muddy chues provide a glimpse of the past and help scientists today learn about the mighty mammals that once ruled the basin.  Time at Lake LuceroAccompany rangers and living history actors from the New Mexico Farm and Ranch Heritage Museum on a journey through the 10,000 years of human habitation in the Tularosa Basin. As you hike to Lake Lucero, colorful characters such as celebrated author Eugene Manlove Rhodes and renowned photographer Ansel Adams, will share the rich history of the basin. Program fee: $\$ 8.00$ per adult ( 16 years and older), $\$ 4.00$ for children. Reservations are required and will be accepted starting on October 7th at www.nps.gov/ whsa.
