## Condition and Preservation

The bound newspaper volumes are very fragile with torn or missing bindings, tears and discoloration to the pages, and crumbling. To our best knowledge, these are the only original volumes of this newspaper remaining in this area and thus their preservation must be the highest priority.

A preservation project was completed in the Fall of 2009 to clean and securely wrap the volumes in acid-free paper wrapped with cotton ties. Each volume was then housed in a polyethelene bag to protect it from dust and minimize off-gassing.

## Use Policy

Restricted access will only be granted to researchers who apply directly to the Collections Manager. Access will be granted only after researcher has exhausted other possible avenues, including using the microfilmed newspapers at the Pasadena Public Library's main branch.

To apply for access, please write a letter of intent, stating the nature of your research and the outcome of it (for personal use, publishing, school project, etc.). Please specify which volumes you need to use and how long you expect your research to take.

Please note, the Pasadena Museum of History reserves the right to refuse permission to use the newspapers due to their fragile nature. Copies cannot be made from the newspapers, although limited photography may be allowed.
