"Do Justice, Love Goodness, Walk Humbly with God" (Micah 6:8)

The Office for Catholic Social Justice Ministry will award a \$100 prize to the archdiocesan first place winner in each of the two contest age groups (grades 7-9 and 10-12), as well as the chance to win at the national level!

The National Grand Prize is \$500, a \$500 matching grant to a community organization working to fight poverty, AND a trip to a national awards event. Second (\$375) and third place (\$250) prizes and matching grants will also be awarded. In addition, the national winners' schools will receive a \$500, \$250, or \$150 gift certificate (for grand prize, 2nd place, and 3rd place respectively), from RCL Benziger.

All participants will have the opportunity to display their work at the 6th Annual Bishop Peter Rosazza Social Justice Conference on June 13, 2015 and the awards will be awarded during this event.
