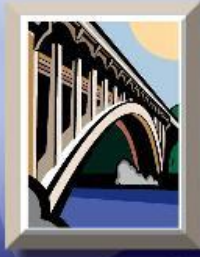

## Annual parade honors veterans

Join your flag-waving friends and neighbors at Folsom's 14<sup>th</sup> Annual Wayne Spence Veterans Day Parade beginning at 9 a.m. Tuesday, Nov. 11. The parade will feature marching bands and drill teams; floats; veteran, scout and youth groups; Ben Ali Shrine go-carts; classic cars; Keystone Cops and clowns.

The theme of the 2014 parade is "Land of the Free, Because of the Brave." The grand marshal will be Ret. Lt. Col. Frank Hilscher, 91, who served in the United States Air Force for over 26 years. He flew over 100 missions in the Korean war and received the Distinguished Flying Cross and the Air Medal.

The parade begins in front of Target on East Bidwell Street and follows East Bidwell, Coloma and Natoma streets to the Veterans Memorial near the City Hall complex. The judges review stand will be near the end of the parade route in City Lions Park. Excellent viewing spots are available at any point along the route.
